SCHOOL FEES, PAYMENT SCHEDULES AND STRUCTURE

Our school fees payment plan remains the same for Pre-School and Basic School. We ask that parents pay attention to the schedule and do well not to default on their payments this term as this makes running the affairs of the school quite difficult for school management.

DUE DATES

For Day students, the due dates for payments based on the payment schedule are as follows:

Payment schedule: 50% on the first day of reopening and the remaining 50% to be split into 2 instalments.

- ✓ 1st Instalment (50%) – 4th May
- ✓ 2nd Instalment (25%) – 1st June
- ✓ 3rd Instalment (15%) – 1st July

For boarders:

- ✓ Half payment on arrival (before entry into Boarding house) - 4th May
- ✓ Final (half) payment after mid-term (before entry into Boarding house) - 28th June

NOTE: Boarders who do not go for mid-term will be sent home to collect fees.

MODES OF PAYMENT

The following are acceptable modes of payment:

FEEDING FEE

Our feeding fee has been adjusted upwards effective May 4th [i.e. the start of second term]. This is as a result of increased prices of items on the market. We sent a note to this effect at the end of last term.

Please find below the price changes:

- Breakfast remains 2 cedis
- Lunch is now 8 cedis
- Supper [boarders] 5 cedis
- TOTAL:** **15 cedis** [per day]

Next term is a term of 98 days so ideally boarders should be paying GH¢ 1470. However, this has been scaled down to GH¢ 1176 [at 12 cedis a day].

For day students, feeding fee is payable weekly, monthly or termly at these rates:

- Breakfast and Lunch: 10 cedis a day – 50 cedis weekly
- Lunch only: 8 cedis a day – 40 cedis weekly

The monthly and termly bill for feeding fee [for day students] is as detailed below.

FULL TERM: • LUNCH ONLY @ **8/day** = 61 x 8 = 488
• BREAKFAST & LUNCH @ **10/day** = 61 x 10 = 610

Please note: We will no longer be accepting feeding fee payments where payments are made based on a student's present/absent days from school. Every student is included in our planning for feeding. Therefore, apart from days when school is not in session [e.g. holidays or mid-term break], parents would be expected to pay the full amount for feeding fee regardless of whether their ward was in school or not.


