SCHOOL FEES & PAYMENT SCHEDULES

Student bills were made available last year on the final day of term.

For Day students, the payment plan is as follows for those who are unable to fully pay at the beginning of the term:

- ✓ 2nd Instalment (25%) – Tuesday, August 1st, 2023
- ✓ 3rd Instalment (25%) – Monday, August 28th, 2023

For boarders, the payment plan is as follows for those who are unable to fully pay at the beginning of the term:

- ✓ 1st Instalment (50%) – Monday, July 3rd, 2023
- ✓ 2nd Instalment (50%) – Monday, August 7th, 2023

The 2nd instalment is the final instalment of fees for boarders. Parents must ensure that upon their ward's return from mid-term [Monday, August 7th, 2023], fees have been settled in full.

We have noted, with much regret, that parents disregard the payment plan. This makes things very difficult for us. Kindly do your best to follow the payment schedule given to avoid any unpleasant incidents.

PARENTS' ROLE AND COMMITMENT

Our gratitude goes out to parents who support their children in their academic work. We really appreciate you. We would ask that parents and guardians take an active role in the supervision of their children's work to ensure that their academic work is at optimum level. One way to actively do this is to attend Open Days in order to discuss your child(ren)'s academic work with their teachers. Parents are also encouraged to periodically call for their child(ren)'s books, look at their work, sign their homework, etc.

Also very important, as stated earlier, is the need for parents to follow the fee payment schedule diligently this academic year. We need your support in this regard to run the school.

HYGIENE PROTOCOLS AND SAFETY MEASURES

It has been noted that parents under-supply their children with toiletries. This is very dangerous for the health of their children – one toothpaste a term is unacceptable. Some come without toilet rolls and very few bathing soap and washing soap. All these will be inspected to ensure that all students have an adequate supply of health and hygiene products.

We would like to encourage parents to do their best to ensure that their wards diligently adhere to safety and hygiene protocols. Students are encouraged to mask up on account of the reported new variants of Covid-19, as well as the weather and dust. On arrival at the school every morning, all are expected to wash their hands at the hand-washing station at the gate. Kindly provide your ward with hand sanitizer.

Parents who are able to support the school with gifts of Thermometer guns, Veronica buckets and Sanitizer or Soap dispensers are still welcome to do so. These would be greatly appreciated.

EVENING SCHOOL

Evening School is highly necessary for Junior High 2 and 3 students especially. We have some external teachers who support us with their expertise as examiners. We encourage parents to enrol their wards for Evening School. For Day students, this is at a monthly cost of GH¢ 150.00 and includes feeding fee for Supper. It will run from 5pm to 7pm.

TIME OF CATERING WITH THE LADIES

This is our catering programme which we usually hold on the last Saturday of each month where we have a practical catering session at the school. We will continue this term. This programme is targeted especially at ladies from Basic 3 to JHS. However, our young men are invited to attend too. It is optional and it will be at a monthly fee of GH¢ 60.00. The full bill for this term will be GH¢ 60.00 as we would only have one session.

FIELD TRIP

Last term, we had to cancel our excursion on account of very bad weather. We would like to propose a new date to parents for our educational/field trip: Friday, 21st July, 2023. We would like to ask that parents pay a fee of GHS 50 towards the trip to make up for all the expenses that were incurred even though we could not actually go on the trip.
