SCHOOL FEES & PAYMENT SCHEDULES

Student bills were made available on the final day of last term.

For Day students, the payment plan is as follows for those who are unable to fully pay at the beginning of the term:

DUE	Due Date	Instalment
50%	Thursday, January 8, 2026	1st
25%	Monday, February 2, 2026	2nd
25%	Monday, March 2, 2026	3rd

For day students, the 3rd instalment is the final instalment of fees and parents must ensure that by then their ward's fees have been settled in full.

FEEDING



Many day students pay their feeding fee monthly. We would like to encourage parents to sign up to pay monthly to help us to stop the daily market trips which are quite costly overall. Being able to buy our food items in bulk would greatly help us.

Please note that those who genuinely cannot afford to make monthly payments can still make weekly payments.



About feeding fee payments

Please note that whether one opts to pay weekly, monthly or termly, payment is due **in advance** of whatever period one is paying for.

Please note that for lunch only, the fee is GH¢ 20.00 a day and for breakfast and lunch, the fee is GH¢ 25.00 a day.

UNIFORMS

These are the usual uniforms and the days on which they are worn. Any changes to this would be announced to the school.

UNPRESCRIBED CLOTHING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED!

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Our school uniform is worn from Mondays to Thursdays.

[Except on Fridays when we wear our P.E. kit and on days when we wear our school cloth]

WHITE CEREMONIAL SHIRT

During our 2025 Carol Service, we wore dressy white shirts and blouses with our school cloth. That attire will serve as our additional ceremonial wear henceforth.

WHITE POLO SHIRT ➔

On Tuesdays and Thursdays, students may wear the school branded white polo shirts with their school uniform shorts, skirt or pinafore.



P.E. KIT

The P.E. kit is worn on Fridays (except on the last Friday of the month).

SCHOOL CLOTH

The School cloth is worn on/for:

- the first Wednesday of the month (for our Anointing Service)
- the last Friday of the month
- ceremonial events (e.g., Graduation & Prize-Giving Days)

For boys, the school cloth is worn over **black trousers with black shoes**. *No jeans, please!*

*Girls are strictly to wear **FLAT HEELED black shoes** for school activities & church services.*



ADDITIONAL CEREMONIAL WEAR: WHITE SHIRTS

During our 2025 Carol Service, we wore dressy white shirts and blouses with our school cloth. That attire will serve as our additional ceremonial wear.

Boarders are reminded to pack their white shirts and bring them to school.



UNPRESCRIBED CLOTHING

We would like to urge parents to check the contents of their their wards' suitcases when they are coming to school.

For boarders, especially, unprescribed clothing is not permitted in the school.

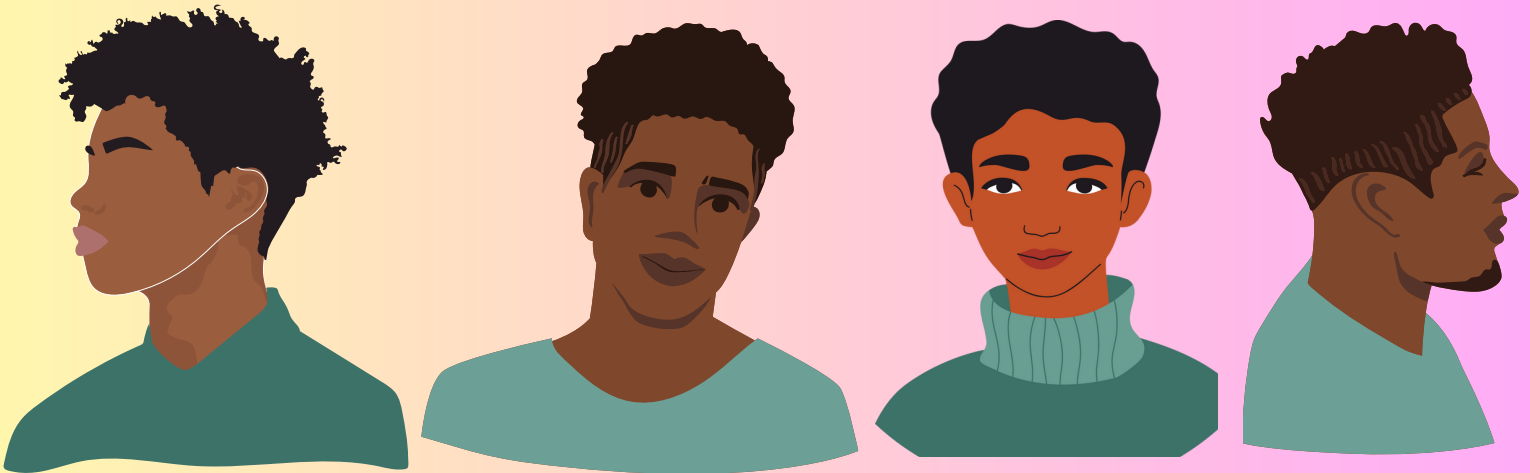
VISITING HOURS



VISITING HOURS FOR BOARDERS

Visiting hours run from 3 to 5 p.m. [on weekends] for all except for Junior High learners [who have class till 5 p.m.] For JHS, parents are encouraged to come before 3 p.m. or from 5 to 6 p.m. without extension.

Some parents reportedly come to the school as late as 8 p.m. Kindly note that this will no longer be allowed as the security has instructions to let no one in after the designated times.



STUDENTS' HAIRCUT

Pictured above are examples of the types of haircut and stylings which are unacceptable for students. Unkempt hair, overgrown hair and side fades are examples of unruly hairstyles that will not be tolerated.

Parents should kindly ensure that the haircut rules are not flouted.



HYGIENE PROTOCOLS AND SAFETY MEASURES

We would like to encourage parents to do their best to ensure that their wards diligently adhere to safety and hygiene protocols. Students should continue to practice good hygiene on account of the weather and dust. On arrival at the school, all are expected to wash their hands at the hand-washing station at the gate. Kindly provide your ward with hand sanitizer. Parents who are able to support the school with gifts of Thermometer guns, Veronica buckets and Sanitizer or Soap dispensers are still welcome to do so. These would be greatly appreciated.



TOILETRIES

We have noted that some boarders do not come to school with enough toiletries and/or hygiene supplies to last them the term. Requests to replenish their finished supplies are often ignored. Consequently, parents are being notified that they are required to provide their wards with the appropriate amount of toiletries they need for the term. The following list captures the minimum amount of toiletries required [and which will be inspected on reopening]:

- 6 bathing soap
- 2 key soap
- Dettol
- Toilet roll
- 2 tooth paste
- 2 tooth brushes
- 2 towels
- Sponge
- Deodorant or lime squeezed in a bottle (age: 13+)
- Sanitary pads/diapers (depending on age)
- Hair brush/comb
- Pegs (enough for the year)

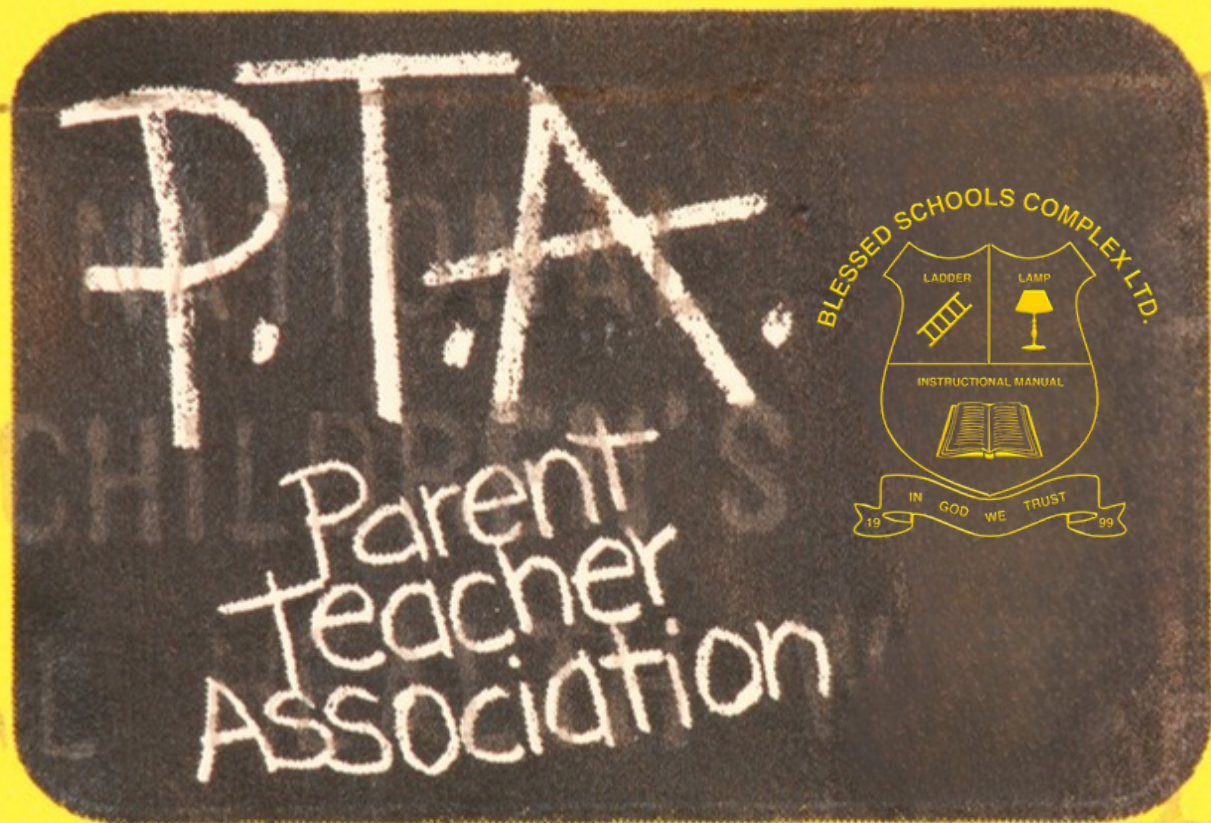
**Attire for extra classes is strictly the BLUE CHECK.
Day students are not allowed to wear mufti. This will be strictly enforced.**

Evening School is very necessary for Junior High 2 and 3 students especially. We have some external teachers who support us with their expertise as examiners.

We encourage parents to enroll their wards for Evening School.

This is at a monthly cost of GH¢ 200.00 [a subsidized fee which is supper inclusive].

Please note that our Evening School fee covers Weekend Classes as well. Attending weekend classes is only allowed for learners who have paid for Evening School. Some very good externals come at the weekend and parents of JHS 2 and 3 day students are encouraged to pay the fees to ensure their children are in school for these lessons.

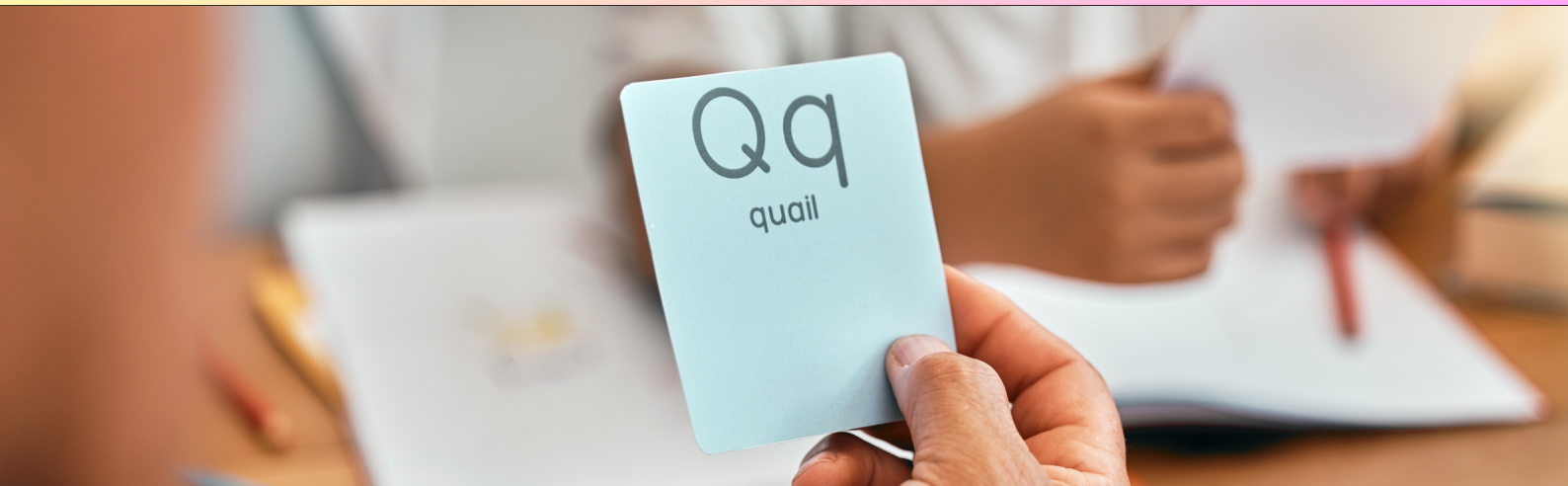

MATTRESSES FOR BOARDERS

Since the inception of the Boarding School, the school has always provided mattresses for boarders. It is becoming increasingly difficult to provide mattresses or even maintain them. Our mattresses were all leather-covered by Latex Foam. Students have torn these covers and destroyed the bulk of these mattresses. We have had to and are having to dispose off mattresses.

Parents of continuing boarding students are therefore encouraged to buy mattresses for their children and make arrangements to take them home at the end of every term.



PARENTS' ROLE AND COMMITMENT

Our gratitude goes out to parents who support their children in their academic work. We really appreciate you. We would ask that parents and guardians take an active role in the supervision of their children's work to ensure that their academic work is at optimum level. One way to actively do this is to attend Open Days in order to discuss your child(ren)'s academic work with their teachers. Parents are also encouraged to periodically call for their child(ren)'s books, look at their work, sign their homework, etc.
