SCHOOL FEES, PAYMENT SCHEDULES AND STRUCTURE

Our school fees payment plan remains the same. We ask that parents pay attention to the schedule and do well not to default on their payments this term as this makes running the affairs of the school quite difficult for school management. Ideally, parents are required to pay in full on reopening but the school acknowledges that it may not be possible for everybody. This understanding explains the payment schedule provided.

Payment schedule: 50% on the first day of reopening and the remaining 50% to be split into two instalments.

DUE DATES

For Day students, the due dates for payments based on the payment schedule are as follows:

- ✓ 1st Instalment (50%) 5th September
- ✓ 2nd Instalment (25%) 3rd October
- ✓ 3rd Instalment $(25\%) 1^{st}$ November

For boarders:

- ✓ Half payment on arrival (before entry into Boarding house)
 5th September
- ✓ Final (half) payment after mid-term (before entry into Boarding house) 1st November

NOTE: Boarders who do not go for mid-term will be sent home to collect fees.

<u>Please note</u>: We will no longer be accepting feeding fee payments where payments are made based on a student's present/absent days from school. Every student is included in our planning for feeding.

Therefore, apart from days when school is not in session [e.g., holidays or mid-term break], parents would be expected to pay the full amount for feeding fee, regardless of whether their ward was in school or not.
